



## Frequently Asked Questions

**25. Where a subsystem integrates an IC/ISV: Does the subsystem NoBo need to receive the full IC/ISV NoBo-Conformity Assessment Report / NoBo file and related documents?**

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All information, as listed in RFU-STR-011, for NoBo conformity assessment reports on ICs must be available to the subsystem NoBo (refer to the modules decision 2010/713/EU), including cases where such information is contained in separate documents.

The subsystem NoBo needs access to all of this information to be able to complete the 'EC' Verification of the subsystem.

Yes, the subsystem NoBo has the right to receive the full report. The IC Conformity Assessment Report is an integral part of the certificate, see RFU-STR-001. Receiving only an extract of the IC Conformity Assessment Report (e. g. just one page) is not sufficient. The complete Conformity Assessment Report is needed to complete the 'EC' Verification of the subsystem. This also includes any document to which the IC Conformity Assessment Report refers to in the context of conditions and limits for use (e. g. SRACS from a Safety Case or installation manuals). This applies mutatis mutandis to ISVs.
